## **Storehouse Principles**

1. God can do more with the 90 percent that is blessed than we can do with the 100 percent without His blessing
2. Giving increases our joy
3. To be blessed beyond your ability you must give beyond your ability
4. When we start tithing our financial problems become God's problems
5. The tithe is the only thing that keeps us away from the "love of money"
6. Honoring God with the tithe places you in the blessing zone
